<b>What is the overall deductible?</b>	Network: \$2,500 Individual/\$7,500 Family. Out-of-Network: \$5,000 Individual/\$15,000 Family.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?</b>	Doesn't apply to In-Network Preventive Care, In-Network office visits, or Prescription Drugs. Copays and prescription drug costs don't count toward the overall Deductible.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. **Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes**

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.

## About These Coverage Examples:



**This is not a cost estimator.** Treatments shown are just examples of how this plan might cover medical care. Your actual costs will be different depending on the actual care you receive, the prices your providers charge, and many other factors. ### Peg is Having a baby
